


Viola Field- Tuesdays & Thursdays- Beginning June 3rd & June 6th.

City of Carpinteria Co-Ed Softball (10 Games) Rules and Regulations

Rules and conditions of Play shall follow the rules as are outlined for regular softball in the SCMAF Softball Rule Book with the following exceptions:

- All money is due on or before the last day of registration (the Managers Meeting).**
- MANAGERS- You are responsible for your team including sportsmanship and behavior at all times.**
- We will play by SCMAF rules.
- S.C.M.A.F. - 12' arc limit.
- A defensive team shall consist of ten (10) players. However, a game may be played without forfeit with eight (8) rostered players and a minimum of three (3) women. Replacements must be of the same sex as the individual being replaced.
- Batting order. A batting order may not exceed sixteen (16) players.
- Courtesy runners are allowed. One per inning maximum.
- No alcohol** is allowed in the City Park. A team may be disqualified for alcohol consumption.
- A game will end any time after five (5) innings, when a team is behind twelve (12) runs, and has completed its turn at bat.
- There will be no restrictions on a player as to which defensive position he or she may play.
- The age requirement for league play is eighteen (18) years of age or older. **Minors 16 years or older may play w/signed parent waiver.**
- Roster may not exceed sixteen (16) players including a playing manager -- no players will be permitted to be added after the fifth game.
- Respect must be always shown to the umpires.**
- All players in a team entering tournament play must be on same team's league roster.
- A team may add players to their league roster. All roster changes must be made (written) by 5:00 p.m. before team's fifth game.
- Time of game and innings. All games will be seven (7) innings or no new inning after (55) fifty-five minutes of play, whichever occurs first for all games except final championship games which have no time limit. Any innings started will be completed.
- Base runners advance only if forced to vacate their bases.
- If a team can't make a scheduled game the game will be forfeited. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Substitutions: A player from another team, may substitute for a team, only if said player makes 9 player's total.
- All team members MUST sign waivers to participate in the league. If the waiver for a player is not signed that player may not participate.**
- Players must participate in a minimum of 4 games to be eligible to participate in the playoffs. Sign-in sheets will be used to verify eligibility. It is the manager's responsibility to make sure all players are signed in prior to the game.
- In order to avoid possible accidents, all base runners are required to slide into home plate as a play is made. Failure to slide will result in an automatic out. This is an umpire desecration call and not subject to appeal.
- Runners going to first must step on base to right of 1st baseman.
- 1 hr. 10 min. games from the time the umpire calls.
- 12 run mercy rules after 5 innings.
- NO APPEALS!**
- All players must sign-in before first game.
- Absolutely no beer in dugouts and No Drinking during Game.
- No bats which exceed 1.2 BPF.
- If batter has 2 strikes and hits a foul ball – he/she is out. (1 to waste-3rd strike)
- If a male batter is pitched four balls and is awarded second base, then next female batter can either hit or take first base, if open.
- Five minute grace period after start - for late starts, but time is deducted from 1 hour 10-minute game time.
- No ball throwing between innings.
- No metal spikes
- NO BLOOD** – bandage must be securely in place.

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
