# STUDENTS AT THE MILL COMMUNITY COVENANT

*Here is a reminder of our SATM Community Covenant that you signed throughout the registration.*

## DAY 2 :: GOD'S PURPOSE

Even though Jonah was flawed and reluctant, God used his obedience to preach a message that led to the salvation of the Ninevites. This shows that God can use anyone to accomplish His plan, and a person's resistance or sin does not necessarily stop God from working through them. This should give us great hope that God can use anyone.

**Proverbs 21:19** tells us "Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the Lord that will stand."

The writer of Proverbs, Solomon, was the wisest man who ever lived. While he didn't always make the best decisions, he was wise enough to know that human plans are never guaranteed to work out. He observes here that only God's purposes are the ones that will last.

As we think about God's purpose, here are some promises for believers:

**Romans 8:28:** "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose".

**Ephesians 2:10:** "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do".

**Philippians 2:13:** "For it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose"

Each of these verses are connected to show us how we are to accomplish God's purpose. God has called us to his purpose (Romans 8:38) which is to come to faith in him and in that faith do good works (Ephesians 2:10). We do not create this faith, it's God who works in us so that we can live out his purpose (Philippians 2:13).

**REFLECTION QUESTIONS:**

What are some of things in your life you think keep you from being used by God? (This could include age, family situation, sin pattern, simply don't want to, not knowing what to say or where to start, etc.) \_\_\_\_\_

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How do the verses encourage you to push past those reasons? \_\_\_\_\_

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What is one thing you know God's been asking you to do, but you haven't been obedient to? What would it take for you to obey? \_\_\_\_\_

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**BOTTOM LINE:**

God can use anyone for His purpose.

## **PRAYER GUIDE:**

**Adoration:** Thank God for wanting to use you for his purposes, even when you don't want to be used.

**Confession:** Admit any disobedience you have in your life.

**Thanksgiving:** Thank God for not giving up on you and wanting to work in and through you.

**Supplication:** Ask God to give you ears to hear his voice. Also ask Him to give you the strength and courage to do what he asks you to do.



# DAY 3

### **DAY 3 :: GOD'S COMPASSION**

When we look at the story of Jonah, we often think about him being swallowed by a giant fish, and rightly so! But the story of Jonah is so much more than that. Today we want to spend some time thinking about God's compassion. When we talk about God's compassion we mean his gracious, merciful, loving nature. We see his compassion play out in Jonah's story in two ways:

1. God shows concern for all people, including the Ninevites who were enemies of the Israelites (God's people). Jonah's anger at God's mercy for the Ninevites reveals that he had prejudice against them. God's concern highlights his love is for all people, and we should not be blinded by our own hatred or prejudice.
2. God's compassion on Jonah. God could have left him in the fish, but he chose to rescue him and offers him the same call to go to the people of Nineveh.

Take a look at these scriptures about God's compassion.

**Psalms 145:8:** The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and great in love.

**Lamentations 3:22-23:** Because of the Lord's faithful love we do not perish, for his mercies never end. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness! I say, "The Lord is my portion, therefore I will put my hope in him."

**2 Corinthians 1:3-4:** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort. He comforts us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any kind of affliction, through the comfort we ourselves receive from God. For just as the sufferings of Christ overflow to us, so also through Christ our comfort overflows.

## REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

Who are those people you think are outside of **God's** love? How has the story of Jonah challenged and changed your thought of them? \_\_\_\_\_

What does it mean that God is "slow to anger, and great in love"? \_\_\_\_\_

What are some evidences of God's compassion in your life? \_\_\_\_\_

## APPLICATIONS:

1. Realize that God loves you. Jesus's life, death and resurrection is the proof of God's love for you.
2. Thank God for his mercy. God's mercy means he does not give what our sin deserves. Our sin deserves death, but God put that punishment on his son.
3. Rest in God's graciousness. God's grace means he gives us what we do not deserve, that's salvation in his son.

**BOTTOM LINE:** God's compassion is for everyone.

## PRAYER GUIDE:

**Adoration:** Thank God for who he is and for his grace and mercy.

**Confession:** Admit if there is anyone you think is unworthy of God's love. Confess any time you fail to acknowledge his compassion in your own life.

**Thanksgiving:** Thank God for his mercy and grace that only comes through Christ.

**Supplication:** Ask God to help you see people like he does and for help to not take his compassion for granted in your own life.


