Consolidated Activity Report for 2023-24

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit No – 1306 has successfully conducted various activities during the academic year 2023-24, reflecting its commitment to societal service and community development. Through a range of initiatives, NSS volunteers have actively contributed to environmental conservation, health awareness, education, and community welfare. The key activities undertaken are highlighted below:

1. Environmental Initiatives:

NSS volunteers have played a vital role in environmental conservation through multiple temple cleaning activities at Chellangkuppam, Tsunami Nagar Village, Eni Karan Thottam Village, and Pachyankuppam Village, involving a total of 160 participants. Additionally, a school cleaning drive and a tree plantation program at UBA Village reinforced the importance of a cleaner and greener environment.

2. Health and Hygiene Awareness:

Prioritizing community health, NSS organized an awareness program on health hygiene, benefiting 100 participants. Two Blood Donation Camps at CKCET saw overwhelming participation from 195 donors, promoting the noble cause of saving lives. A mental health and well-being awareness program also reached 100 attendees, stressing the importance of emotional well-being.

3. Educational and Technological Awareness:

In an effort to promote STEM education, 65 participants were engaged in an awareness session. A cyber security awareness program enlightened 120 individuals about digital safety and responsible internet use.

4. Social Responsibility and Community Engagement:

Volunteers visited OASIS Orphanage, bringing joy and support to 30 children. A voters' awareness rally encouraged civic responsibility among 50 participants. Additionally, a community awareness and signature campaign on World No Tobacco Day engaged 150 people, advocating for a healthier lifestyle.

5. Government Schemes and Rural Development:

Under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) scheme, NSS actively participated in Grama Sabha meetings and conducted an awareness program on Central and State Government schemes, aiming to empower rural communities with knowledge of welfare programs.

Through these initiatives, NSS Unit No – 1306 has significantly contributed to societal well-being, fostering a spirit of volunteerism and social responsibility among students. Moving forward, the unit remains committed to serving the community and inspiring positive change.


