The Coalition to Stop Violence Against Native Women (CSVANW) has carefully curated this comprehensive list of organizations that provide crucial assistance and support. Many of these organizations offer culturally sensitive services specific to Native American communities, recognizing the unique needs and traditions of tribal populations. This cultural sensitivity is a key directory feature, making it a particularly valuable resource for those seeking support. These agencies create a robust support network that can more effectively address survivors' complex needs by working together. Many of the listed organizations offer:

- 24/7 crisis hotlines and crisis intervention
- Emergency shelters and housing/financial support
- Social work and case management
- Legal support and advocacy
- Counseling, therapy, behavioral health, and support groups
- Medical assistance, forensic services, and reproductive health services
- Cultural and traditional healing services
- Education and prevention programs
