CART Captioning Service Guide

Communication Access Real-time Translation (CART) is a form of captioning that DSU can provide, remotely or on-site, that displays the voice-to-text translation of spoken English into written English directly onto your device. Here is some helpful information about CART captioning and some steps to get you started when using CART services:

TypeWell and C-Print

These services are similar to CART in that the service providers for both systems can provide a real-time display of the spoken information. C-Print and Typewell providers, however, provide a meaning-for-meaning representation of the spoken information versus verbatim. This service is typically found in educational environments.

Post-production Captioning

Closed captioning services allow you to make existing video content accessible to those with communication access needs.
