Imprint Art Fair Launches in London, Positioning Print as the Gateway to Collecting Contemporary Art

London, UK – A new contemporary art fair dedicated to print and editions will launch in London in October 2026. **Imprint Art Fair** will bring together leading galleries, publishers and artists working in print, creating a platform designed to introduce a new generation of collectors to contemporary art.

Taking place at **RHS Lawrence Hall from 28 October to 01 November 2026**, the Fair will explore contemporary printmaking through exhibitions, talks and live demonstrations, presenting the medium as both a site of artistic innovation and a powerful entry point into collecting.

For generations, many of the world's most serious collectors began by acquiring prints. Through editions, artists are able to produce work that exists at multiple price points while maintaining the intellectual and material depth of contemporary art.

Imprint positions print and editions as a gateway into the contemporary art world, creating an environment where both new and experienced collectors can engage with significant artistic practices.

The Fair will be organised around three interconnected programmes: Fair, Forum and Studio.

The Fair will present a curated selection of international galleries, publishers and print studios exhibiting editions and works on paper by leading contemporary artists.

The Forum programme will bring together artists, curators and publishers for talks and discussions exploring the role of print within contemporary art and the evolving culture of collecting.

The Studio programme will reveal the collaborative and material nature of printmaking through demonstrations and workshops with leading print studios and artists.

Together, these programmes position print as both an artistic medium and a cultural platform through which audiences can discover, understand and begin collecting contemporary art.

Imprint Art Fair builds on more than a decade of experience developing **Woolwich Contemporary Print Fair**, the leading international art fair for contemporary print, which established a global community around contemporary print and supported thousands of artists working in the medium.

Imprint reflects a renewed vision for presenting boundary-pushing original print and editions within the broader context of contemporary art.

Further announcements regarding participating galleries, programme speakers and partnerships will be made in the coming months.

About Imprint Art Fair

Imprint is a contemporary art fair dedicated to original print and editions, introducing a new generation of collectors to contemporary art through the medium of print. By bringing together galleries, artists and publishers working in print, the fair creates a platform where collecting, artistic practice and cultural discourse intersect.

The first edition of Imprint Art Fair will take place at RHS Lawrence Hall in London from 28 October to 01 November 2026.
