

Article 16. COOPERATION AND NOTIFICATION

74-16-1. Cooperation with the board. Each applicant, certified public accountant or firm shall cooperate in a timely manner with the board in its investigation of complaints or possible violations of the accounting statutes or the regulations of the board. Cooperation shall include responding to written communications from the board, and providing information and documentation as requested by the board, sent by mail to the last known preferred mailing address on file with the board, within a reasonable time frame specified by the board or appearing before the board, or any of its members, upon request. 74-16-2. Notification of non-renewal; change of name or address. Each certified public accountant (CPA) shall notify the board in writing if the CPA does not wish to renew the CPA's permit to practice or the registration of an accounting firm within 30 days of the renewal deadline, or of any change in the person's name, home address, employer name, employer address, business name, business address, or electronic-mail address within 30 days of the change.
