**This year we are introducing an A to Z of breweries. Can you work your way through every letter of the alphabet? The event lasts 4 days, we would recommend you do this over at least a couple of days.**

The event kicks off on Thursday 8th May with an evening of Comedy in partnership with the Swindon Old Town Comedy club. We are delighted to welcome TV comic legend Dom Joly as our headliner. On Friday we have our standard beer festival, our flagship day on Saturday begins at 12noon with live local bands from 5pm onwards. The event closes on Sunday with a musical concert from the fabulous local and award winning Wessex choir.

This year you will be given a classic tulip glass with our iconic Christ Church logo.

We're mixing things up this year with a dedicated rum bar, featuring a selection of rums from the Bristol and Bath Rum Distillery. Be sure to sample their delicious flavoured rums!

On Saturday, the Dwelling Place, a Christ Church initiative will be on site in their gazebo raising awareness of what they do. They will offer quiet prayer for anyone who needs it.


Fandangos events will be at the event offering tasters of Moonshine. This will be available to purchase and take away for consumption at home.

**Drinks Vouchers** - There is NO CASH on the bars. We do however exchange beer/cider, crisps, nuts and soft drinks for vouchers. These can be bought in £6 (3 drinks) or £12 (6 drinks) sheets from the welcome stall at the entrance. Cash or Card is fine 1 Token can be used for ½ pint, 1 soft drink or 2 snacks. 2 tokens for a drink of rum or an alcohol free beer/ cider. We can also refund left over money on vouchers (unless you decide to donate it).

**Food outlets** - take payment by cash/ card. Drinks tokens cannot be redeemed from the food outlets.

## The Tinders - 7:30pm


