



AJAPEU LODGE 2 BUCK PASS 2025

ORDER OF THE ARROW

For a total price of \$150, the Ajapeu Lodge 2 Buck Pass allows a Brother to pre-pay the Early Registration Event fees shown below for all 5 main (or “covered”) Ajapeu Lodge 2 Events for 2025:

- Banquet - \$30
- April Induction weekend - \$30
- May Vigil/Service weekend - \$30
- September Induction weekend - \$30
- Fall Fellowship weekend - \$30

The Buck Pass only includes the Event fee for all covered Events identified above. Annual Lodge Dues and additional Event option fees are not included, but can be purchased separately. Past examples of additional Event options are the \$10 Friday night overnight for the 2022 Banquet and the \$5 patch for the 2024 Fall Fellowship weekend.

The Buck Pass was created to simplify the registration payments for Ajapeu Lodge 2 Events and lock in the Early Registration rates, not save additional money. However, it may not make sense for everyone:

- If you attend all 5 Lodge Events and always take advantage of the Early Registration fee, you will be pre-paying, but breaking even.
- If you attend all 5 Lodge Events and miss the Early Registration fee even one time, the Buck Pass will save you money.
- If you do not want to pre-pay Event fees or do not attend all Lodge Events, then the Buck Pass is not for you.

Additionally, Buck Pass holders are eligible to receive the following benefits:

- If you are a Buck Pass holder and your completed health form expires after the last covered Event, which is typically Fall Fellowship, the Lodge will hold onto it (upon request).
- Along with any Brothers who attend all of the covered Lodge Events, Buck Pass holders will automatically qualify for a limited edition annual patch for perfect attendance.

Please note the following:

- So as to not waste food since a Scout is Thrifty, Buck Pass holders are still required to register for each event that they are plan on attending, but at no cost.
- If the health form for a Buck Pass holder is being held by the Lodge, the Buck Pass holder is still required to see the Lodge Medical Officer during check-in in case any has changed.
- If a Buck Pass holder cannot attend a covered Event, there are no provisions for refunding or transferring any portion of the Buck Pass fees.
- In the event that a covered Event is canceled, a proportionate refund or credit from will be offered by the Lodge to Buck Pass holders.

Purchase of the Buck Pass is purely voluntary and an individual decision.
