BECOME A PCP TODAY

Help your Democratic neighbors to be sure they have a plan to vote in every election. Sign up to be a Precinct Committee Person (PCP).

What is a precinct?

- The precinct is the smallest political unit in the country
- The precinct is your neighborhood

Why become a PCP?

- Interested in making a real change
- Want your voice to be heard
- Tired of complaining and want to actually DO something
- Believe in our democracy

What PCPs do as elected officials?

- Elect county party leadership
- Can be delegates to convention at district, state, and/or national level
- Elect replacement state legislators when they retire/resign/die during their term of office
- Support the endorsed candidates of the Party

What do PCPs do at the county level?

- Recruit other Democrats to become precinct committee persons
- Support the endorsed candidates of the Party
- Contribute financially to the County Party

What PCPs do at the precinct level?

- Contact the registered voters who are Democrats by phone, by going door to door, or by sending postcards,
- Hosting a block party...
- Make sure that all new residents are registered to vote with their new address
- Help with the Party's outreach efforts
- Get Out The Vote

How to become a PCP.

- Be a resident of the precinct and a registered voter
- Be appointed by your county chair
- Ask your county chair how to file to get on the ballot each 2-year cycle
- Alternatively, ask your county chair about a write-in campaign

Term of office is approximately two years.
