There are multiple secret spots to enjoy a good culinary experience.

PRACTICAL INFO

We'll meet up at the **Municipal Theatre of Piraeus** and we'll stroll down the liveliest shopping street of the town, **Sotiros Street**, to reach the Marina with the famous **Clock of Piraeus**. Let's start our gastronomy exploration with a traditional Greek breakfast: the crunchy and nutritious "**Koulouri**" sesame bread. We'll make a quick stop to enjoy a cup of freshly brewed Greek coffee paired with a teaspoon sweet on the side at a small family coffee shop of a **Smyrna Family**.

Then, we'll head to the port and walk around **Piraeus Train Station**, just a few steps away from Piraeus' Port, one of the oldest and busiest neighborhoods! On our way there, we won't miss the chance to admire the **post-WWII reconstruction of "Agia Triada" (Holy Trinity) Church**.

We'll visit the local **Food Market**, where locals offer a wide range of traditional Mediterranean fresh food such as meat, fish, vegetables and fruit, olives, spices, and herbs of all kinds, and do some **traditional savory and sweet "Filo-pie" tasting!** Then, we'll find our next stop: a traditional **Greek Coffee Roastery** with a history of 100+ years!



It's time to go to our next destination and pay a visit to a **Traditional Deli** that thrives since 1922! There, we'll taste a variety of Greek products, **cheeses, charcuterie, sudzhuk, and pastrami**.

And it's time for lunch! Our next destination is the perfect place to **taste authentic Mediterranean cuisine**. We'll find ourselves at a small traditional "kafenion" enjoying traditional **seafood meze paired with local wine or ouzo or tsipouro**. We'll please our palate with a delicious syrupy dessert, or kaimaki ice cream with flavorful teaspoon sweets on top, or a traditional submarine sweet.

FOOD ITINERARY

1. Kick off the day with a taste of the traditional **sesame ring-shaped bread “koulouri”**.
2. Quick stop to enjoy the aroma and flavor of **a cup of freshly brewed Greek coffee with teaspoon sweets** on the side at a small family coffee shop of a Smyrna Family.
3. Let's explore the **local food market**; a vibrant, place where locals offer a wide range of traditional Mediterranean fresh food such as meat, fish, cheese, vegetables and fruit, spices, and herbs of all kinds! We'll also taste a variety of **savory and sweet filo-pies!**
4. Walking the streets around the port, we'll find ourselves in **one of the oldest traditional Greek Coffee Roasteries** with a history of over a century! You'll get the chance to buy all essentials to bring this unique aroma home!
5. It's time for a special visit: we'll taste and shop **delicious original Greek products** such as world-renowned Cretan cheese, cured, preserved, and smoked meats, sudzhuk, and pastrami, from **a traditional old-school Greek Deli**.
6. Let's sit together and enjoy **a traditional Mediterranean seafood lunch with Greek fish meze** like Grilled sardines, Smashed fava lentils, and Fried Zucchini paired with some tsipouro, ouzo, or Greek wine! “Yia mas”!
7. We'll finish our culinary experience with **a traditional dessert full of taste at a local Deli: Kaimaki ice cream** with flavorful **teaspoon sweets** on top, **sugary Halva**, or **syrupy desserts such as Kadaifi and Baklava**, or **submarine sweets**.



What's included:

FOODS: One Koulouri (Greek sesame ring-bread), Pie tasting, Deli cheese, and charcuterie tasting, lunch with fish meze at a traditional "Kafenio" (sardines, fried calamari, fried zucchini, smashed fava lentils, tzatziki, etc.), dessert tasting (such as syrupy kadaifi, kaimaki ice cream with teaspoon sweets on top, or submarine sweets, etc.)

DRINKS: Greek coffee, an alcoholic beverage (Greek spirits such as tsipouro or ouzo or local wine), or a non-alcoholic option
