



Celebrating 45 Years of Impact- A Note From Our Executive Director

2025 was a year of meaningful impact and a time for reflection on the incredible accomplishments and decades of service made possible by this organization. What began as a truly grassroots effort has grown into a vital resource for pets and people across Middle Tennessee.

Our accomplishments speak for themselves:

- Since 1992, when Beesley Animal Clinic first opened its doors, 78,022 spay and neuter surgeries have been performed—helping reduce pet overpopulation and improve countless lives.
- In 2018, Beesley Animal Clinic expanded services to include preventative wellness veterinary care, and since that time has served thousands of pets, keeping them healthy, happy, and with the families who love them.
- Our Education Program continues to grow. We now provide Kind News to over 172 fourth and fifth-grade classrooms across Rutherford and Cannon Counties, helping foster compassion and responsible pet ownership in the next generation.
- Believing that no human or pet should go hungry due to financial hardship, our Pet Food Outreach Program has distributed over 51,870 pounds of dog and cat food since 2016.
- Since 2023, the Oliver Pet Assistance Fund has helped 17 pets receive urgent veterinary care, allowing them to remain healthy and with their families.

As our programs continue to grow, so does our belief in the power of the human-animal bond and the importance of keeping pets healthy and in loving homes. With our expanding impact, the Board revisited our mission and vision by asking three guiding questions: The What. The Why. The How. Through this process, our organization is driven by compassion and guided by purpose.


The intention of the **Oliver Pet Assistance Fund** is to help bridge the gap of access to vet care for dogs and cats while keeping families together.




