

Gusty Winds and Hail are the Main Severe Hazards

Key Messages

- A line of showers & storms, ahead of a cold front will work west to east across KY & southern IN during the day Saturday. Some storms could be strong to severe.
- Estimated Timing of Strong/Severe Storms:
 - ◆ 8 AM - 12 PM EST (West of I-65)
 - ◆ 12 PM - 1 PM EST (I-65 Corridor)
 - ◆ 1 PM - 4 PM EST (East of I-65)
- Main Severe Weather Threats: Gusty winds and small hail.
- **Be Weather Aware & Ready to Act.** Have multiple ways to receive warning information!

A cold front Saturday, along with additional systems next week, will bring more rain with the focus shifting farther to the south and west.

- **Area-wide totals of 1 - 3", locally 4" of rain is possible.**
